

We invite you to participate in the Society of Women Engineers - Southeast Florida Section's 2017 university scholarship competition!

APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be a female in her senior year of high school in Martin, Palm Beach, Broward, or Miami-Dade County, Florida and planning to enroll at a college/university no later than fall term 2017.
- Must pursue an ABET-accredited engineering degree at a college/university.
- Must include academic information completed by high school counselor. Applications without a high school counselor signature will not be considered.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

Academic Preparation (25 percent)

This information is provided by your high school counselor and transcripts.

Community Service and Activities (25 percent)

Attach a one-page resume indicating community service and extracurricular activities (e.g., clubs, sports) that you were involved in during high school. Include offices or leadership positions held, hours per week, and what you learned or gained from the experience.

Awards and Honors (10 percent)

On the one-page resume, include a list of all awards and honors you have received during high school with date of recognition and reason for merit.

Work Experience (10 percent)

On the one-page resume, indicate if you had a job during high school. Include your supervisor's name and phone number, hours per week, and what you learned or gained from the experience.

Essay (30 percent)

Attach a one-page essay explaining why you are pursing engineering as a career choice. Explain what or who influenced you to study engineering, as well as what qualities or abilities you possess that you feel will make you well suited to become an engineer. Essay will be graded on content, neatness, grammar, spelling, and creativity.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICATION SUBMISSION:

Complete the application form; have the academic portion of the form completed and signed by high school counselor. Email the completed application (including all required attachments) by **April 28**, **2017 at 5:00 PM EST** to <u>emodlin@geosyntec.com</u>. Applications received after this time will not be considered.
