WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THIS SCHOLARSHIP?

The purpose of the Minority Scholarship Program in Journalism is to provide financial assistance to highly motivated racial minority high school students who are pursuing a college degree in a field of journalism. The program also provides practical on-the-job experience for students during two paid summer internships at The Palm Beach Post.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR THIS SCHOLARSHIP?

For the purpose of this program, minority is defined as Alaskan native, Asian, Black, Hispanic, Native American or Pacific Islander. Applicants must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher. The program is open to students who have shown promise for a career in print or digital journalism. The program is open to students attending public or private high schools. Priority will be given to students with financial need. For this reason, applicants must submit a copy of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) Student Aid Report (SAR) along with the application.

HOW ARE RECIPIENTS SELECTED?

A Selection Committee, made up of Palm Beach Post staff members, will review the application packets and select a group of finalists. The finalists will be notified of an interview with the Selection Committee. The winner will be selected and notified by telephone and letter, along with all finalists.

HOW CAN STUDENTS APPLY?

Complete the application. Contact the Community Relations Department at The Palm Beach Post to request an application.

Include the following items in the Application Packet:

- 300-word essay answering the following question: “What distinguishes journalism from other stories on the internet?”
- Minimum of three samples of student’s journalism work (published articles, columns, stories, etc.)
- Copy of High School Transcript
- Copy of Free Application for Federal Student (FAFSA) Student Aid Report (SAR)
- Letter of Recommendation from High School Journalism Teacher
- One Color Headshot Photo
- Guidance Counselor Recommendation (see back of Application)
- Principal Certification (see back of Application)
