SUBJECT: FY24 BOOK ALLOCATION FUNDS FOR LIBRARY MEDIA CENTERS

Under the direction of the Specific Appropriations 8 and 92 of the FY24 General Appropriations Act of the State of Florida, funds designated as the Library Media Allocation are being distributed to schools. These funds may only be used to purchase library media materials normally purchased under Function 6202 and must be cataloged and inventoried as part of the library media collection.

These are the guidelines:

- Purchases must be for library books, eBooks, or electronic media, database subscriptions, and/or periodicals.
- Materials must adhere to the District's Selection Policy 8.12.
- eBooks must be purchased from vendors who provide catalog records and will be visible in Destiny Library Manager.
- MackinVia or Follett eBook Class Sets (class set option) may **not** be purchased with these funds.
- Class Sets may **not** be purchased with these funds.
- Apple Volume Purchase Vouchers may **not** be purchased with these funds.
- Equipment purchases and supplies are **not** eligible expenditures.

Funding for schools with a vacant media specialist position and schools with a media specialist who doesn't hold a valid educational media certificate will be directly expended by Library Media Services in the best interest of the school's library collection.

In keeping with the requirements outlined in <u>House Bill 1467</u>, all orders must be uploaded to the library media page on the District website for public comment by school community stakeholders. All orders will be held for two weeks to allow for public comment. For all purchases, the certified library media specialist must have completed the new state-required training before the certified media specialist may make any book purchases.

All purchases must be made before Monday, March 18, 2024. Additionally, all purchases over \$1,000 require a requisition which must be entered into PeopleSoft by Monday, March 18, 2024. P-Card purchases must be made no later than Monday, March 25, 2024, to ensure that the purchase is reconciled by Friday, April 26, 2024.

Funds unencumbered by the deadline will be retracted from school budgets on Friday, April 26, 2024. In addition, schools must ensure that P-Card orders are reconciled by April 26, 2024. Schools will be responsible for any negative balances created by not adhering to these deadlines.

For schools with a certified library media specialist, funds will be transferred into the Funding Strip shown below:

Buyer MO should be used for all purchase orders, including all book orders, so that Library Media Services can track the order and ensure items are shelf-ready processed. If the school elects to purchase items other than print books, a budget transfer can be made to any of the following account numbers.

When placing orders in PeopleSoft, school treasurers must use the **Buyer\_MO** new path link for books and audiovisual materials. Filling in the funding strip with **BUD MGR MO01** <u>does not</u> automatically send the requisition on the new path for **BUYER\_MO**.
