

The Palm Beach County Sheriff's Foundation (PBCSF) is pleased to announce the availability of our Youth Scholarship Program for deserving high school seniors in Palm Beach County who have been nominated by a sworn employee of the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO).

There is a total of \$20,000 available to be awarded, and each scholarship is renewable for up to 4 years provided the student reapplies each year and maintains a 3.0 GPA average at the end of each academic year.

Scholarships awarded will range between \$1,000 and \$3,000 per year.

Trade schools are eligible.

The deadline for all submissions is 5:00pm on February 1st, 2018.

How to apply...

High School Seniors

The following documents must be received for you to be considered:

- Completed Application (filled out on a computer)
- Typed letter of nomination from a sworn employee of PBSO
- Typed letter of recommendation from a high school teacher or counselor
- Acceptance letter from a college or trade school
- Essay

Please attach a separate, typed essay (2 pages maximum) describing you as a prospective college/trade school student and a future member of the workforce. Provide details of your extracurricular and leadership activities. Describe what it means to you to have PBSO serving your community.

- Recent photo

All of these items need to be sent in one email to Steve.Moss@pbcsf.org no later than 5:00pm on February 1st, 2018.

You will receive confirmation that your email was received. If you don't receive confirmation within 48 hours, contact Steve.

Please note:

- Family members of PBSO employees are not eligible
- Limit of 2 nominations per deputy
- Files must be in Microsoft Word or PDF format
- High School Transcripts are not required
- Detailed financial information is not required
- Scholarship winners and nominating deputies must be present at our luncheon on March 4th, 2018 for students to receive scholarships

- Full Transcript from college or trade school
- Typed letter of recommendation from a current teacher
